#### **PROFESSION**

Bradley Kramer earned his Doctor of Medicine (M.D.) degree from the University of Illinois College of Medicine, where he served as an HIV/AIDS Education Program Coordinator and as a member of the Admissions Interview Committee. Following medical school, he completed his clinical practice at UCLA Medical Center and the West Los Angeles Veterans Hospital, where he provided routine and emergency medical care to civilians and veterans alike. His dedication to patient care and leadership led to his appointment as Intern Liaison to the Residency Committee.

Pursuing a passion for justice, Dr. Kramer earned his Juris Doctor (J.D.) from Stanford University Law School. There, he founded the Medical Ethics & Law Interest Group, combining his medical background with legal scholarship. His legal career has since centered on advocating for patients and healthcare professionals in matters ranging from medical malpractice and personal injury litigation to regulatory compliance and healthcare fraud.

In addition to his legal practice, Dr. Kramer has served as a guest lecturer at medical and legal professional forums, delivering presentations on medical malpractice and healthcare law at institutions such as Providence Holy Cross Medical Center and Southwestern Law School.

Dr. Kramer's writings on medical malpractice, physician recruitment, and healthcare policy have been widely published, further solidifying his reputation as a thought leader in these fields.
